Our values

We offer a high standard of childcare in a nurturing home environment to support children's future success.

Our educational programme is a blended curriculum inspired by the ideas of Maria Montessori, Waldorf-Steiner, and Reggio Emilia philosophies. During a child's early years, particularly up to the age of 6, they can learn effortlessly.

We recognise the multicultural, multi-faith, and ever-changing nature of the United Kingdom; therefore, we promote British Values in our setting. British values include democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty, mutual respect, and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs.



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Our practitioners

Andi's Nursery has a dedicated team of childcare professionals. All staff hold current food hygiene certificates, paediatric first aid qualifications, safeguarding children training, and have clear DBS records. We ensure all staff receive training and are familiar with our policies.

All practitioners will follow the setting's policies and procedures. Each child will be assigned a key person who will communicate with you individually. They will build a bond with you and your child to help ensure a smooth transition from home to our nursery.

Any information regarding the child will be shared on a need-to-know basis. The key person's role is to complete observations of the child, incorporate information from these observations into planning meetings, keep the child's records up to date, and respond to your child's individual needs.



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Paper learning journal

The paper learning journal aims to create a unique record of what each child knows, understands, does, and wants to do, primarily to preserve memories of the child for the future. It is compiled by the child's key person and handed to the parent at the end of the academic year.

Our Paper Learning Journal will feature children's arts and crafts, photographs, drawings, other forms of mark-making, sentences of what the child said, and highlights of the child's term.



Sleep and rest

Your child will be given the opportunity to rest and sleep. Your child's individual sleep patterns will be discussed and agreed upon with you. We recognise that children and parents have individual needs when being settled to sleep; therefore, we would ask you to bring comfort items, toys, and dummies from home.



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Working in Partnership with parents

We understand the importance of nursery and parents working together to ensure children's needs are met and that the transition from home to our setting is as smooth as possible. Please discuss any concerns with us so that we can work together to resolve them.

We will keep you informed about all aspects of your child's care through various means, such as speaking with you at the end of each day, providing daily news on the TV in the lobby, displaying notices about upcoming events or activities, sending regular newsletters to update you on nursery life, conducting regular observations of your child, and sharing these updates with you via the Family app.



The app allows us to update your child's daily activities, including signing in and out times, nappy changes, sleep periods, and meals.

All of this information is available on your child's activity feed and profile, and you can also opt to receive notifications about these events. If you are assigned a Parent login, you can add extra contacts to your child's profile, designate who can collect your child, and send logins to invite those contacts to the app. You can also send messages directly to us through the app.

This may be a private message to a family member, the nursery management, or the staff in the room. If you have been assigned as a Bill Payer or Invoice Recipient, you can access the Balance tab when you log into the app. As a parent, you can manage your own settings.

FINCHLEY ROAD

In the Finchley Road setting, we have two spacious, bright, interconnected rooms (Toddler and Preschool room). We also have a sensory room and a well-equipped garden, encouraging children to explore and connect with nature. The nursery can accommodate 66 children daily, from 18 months to 5 years old. We conduct risk assessments throughout the whole setting to ensure the children's safety. We keep records of accidents, incidents, medication, and visitors.

We believe that all children should have the opportunity to play outdoors every day, regardless of the weather, as long as they have appropriate clothing and activities. We have a beautiful garden where children benefit from custom-made toys, climbing frames, and creative play that balances freedom with safety. We organise activities and share the outdoor areas to provide children with a variety of experiences, including mud play, sensory play, and sand and water stations.

There is a CCTV system inside and outside the building.

Toddler room

The children are approximately 2 to 3 years old, with some having moved on from our younger class. We strive to create a warm and welcoming environment that is safe and secure, allowing the children to learn, thrive, and feel happy in the nursery.

Staff planning and catering for your child's individual needs using the Early Years Foundation Stage, creating a stimulating and nurturing environment for your child to flourish.

We offer extra opportunities for large-scale learning, exploration of natural resources, and physical development. In this room, there are 30 children divided into 3 groups.



Pre-school room

The children in this room are approximately 3-5 years old and are prepared for the later challenges of school.

They are encouraged to be independent, take more responsibility for their environment, and establish their own community boundaries, which they uphold with support from the staff.

They take responsibility for their own care needs where possible and often support each other in learning new skills. In this room, we have 36 children divided into 3 groups.

HOOP LANE LOCATION

In the Hoop lane setting, we have a spacious, bright room for our children. We also have a sensory room, a separate sleeping room and a well-equipped garden, encouraging children to explore and connect with nature. The nursery can accommodate 21 children daily, from 9 months to 2 years old.

We believe that all children should have the opportunity to play outdoors every day, regardless of the weather, as long as they are appropriately dressed and have activities that suit the weather. We have a beautiful garden where children benefit from custom-made toys, climbing frames, and creative play that balances freedom with safety.

Healthy eating

Our menus are nutritionally balanced and prepared fresh each day. We rotate our menus four times a month to ensure all children enjoy a varied diet, regardless of the sessions they attend. We offer Kosher meat and a vegetarian option.

We have a kitchen on-site where we prepare fresh food daily. We make sure all meals are safely prepared and respect the dietary, religious, and cultural needs of all children. Our sample menu is available on our website.

Outings

Children have the opportunity to explore the wider world through trips and visits to interesting places such as museums, farms, local parks, or theatres.

We are closed during the Easter holiday (Spring Holiday), the two last weeks of August (Summer Holiday) and two weeks at Christmas (Winter Holiday).

Registration

We invite you to visit our nursery to see it, meet the team, and ask any questions you may have before registering with us. Once you are satisfied and wish to proceed with the registration, you will be provided with the contract to complete via DocuSign.

A deposit (£1,100) and a joining fee (£100) are required at registration. The deposit will be fully refunded once your child leaves the nursery, provided a minimum of three months' notice has been given.

Once you have completed the contract, transferred the registration fee and deposit, we can confirm the place.

Please note we require a minimum of three full days of sessions each week. Parents applying for government funding places must then enroll for at least four days per week.

Waiting list

If a place isn't immediately available, you can add your name to our waiting list. A refundable registration fee of £100 is required.

Once your payment has been received, you will receive an email confirming your place on the waiting list. You will be contacted if there is a match between your preferred days and the available slots. If you do not accept the offered days, please be aware that your child will remain on the waiting list until your preferred days become available.

Once you accept a place, the refundable waiting list registration fee is considered your non-refundable joining fee. You will also be asked to pay a deposit upon acceptance, which will be fully refundable at the end of the contract.

If you decide to withdraw from the waiting list, your registration fee will be fully refunded.

If we are unable to offer you the space when needed, your waiting list registration fee will be fully refunded.

Accepting deadline

When you are offered a place, you will have 24 hours to accept it. After that period, the place will be offered to the next family on the waiting list.

Cancelling a confirmed place

We require at least three calendar months' written notice, starting from the first day of the month, to cancel the contract

Our fees

Fees include all meals, snacks, refreshments, sheets, blankets, play equipment and facilities, kosher meat, music sessions, multi-sports, a Spanish class, the Famly app, nappies, wipes, creams, suncream, and arts and crafts.

The fee must be paid in advance, and invoices are issued via the Famly app on the 23rd of each month.

Fees are calculated based on the 46 weeks that Andi's Nursery is open each year, divided into 12 equal monthly payments, so you pay the same amount every month. We review our fees each year.

Sibling discount: We offer a 5% reduction if you have two or more siblings attending the nursery simultaneously.

The discount is offered to the child with fewer sessions, or to the oldest child if they have the same number of sessions.

All types of childcare vouchers are accepted, provided they are paid in advance along with the fees, on the 1st of each calendar month.

We hope that the booklet provides you with the information you need to begin partnering with us in the future.
