- All fees are payable a month in advance and will be received by the 1st of each month.
- The late payment charge is £50
- Emergency childcare, late pick or earlier drop off charge is £15/h
- Sibling discount: 5%

- Nursery opening time: 8 am – 6 pm
- Minimum sessions are three full days per week (bookings must include Friday)
- Joining fee: £100 (non-refundable)
- Deposit: £1,100 (fully refundable)

Government Funding

9 months to 3 years old

From September 2025, government funding for 30 hours per week (for 38 weeks) is available to eligible working parents for the term after their child turns 9 months. We are open approximately 46 weeks a year, so this equates to 24.48 hours a week over 4 days.

3 -4 years old

Government funding for 15 hours per week (for 38 weeks) is available to eligible working parents for the term after their child turns 3 years old. We are open approximately 46 weeks a year, so this equates to 12.24 hours a week over 3 days.

Government funding for 30 hours per week (for 38 weeks) is available to eligible working parents for the term after their child turns 3 years old. We are open approximately 46 weeks a year, so this equates to 24.48 hours a week over 4 days.
